if mines get developed

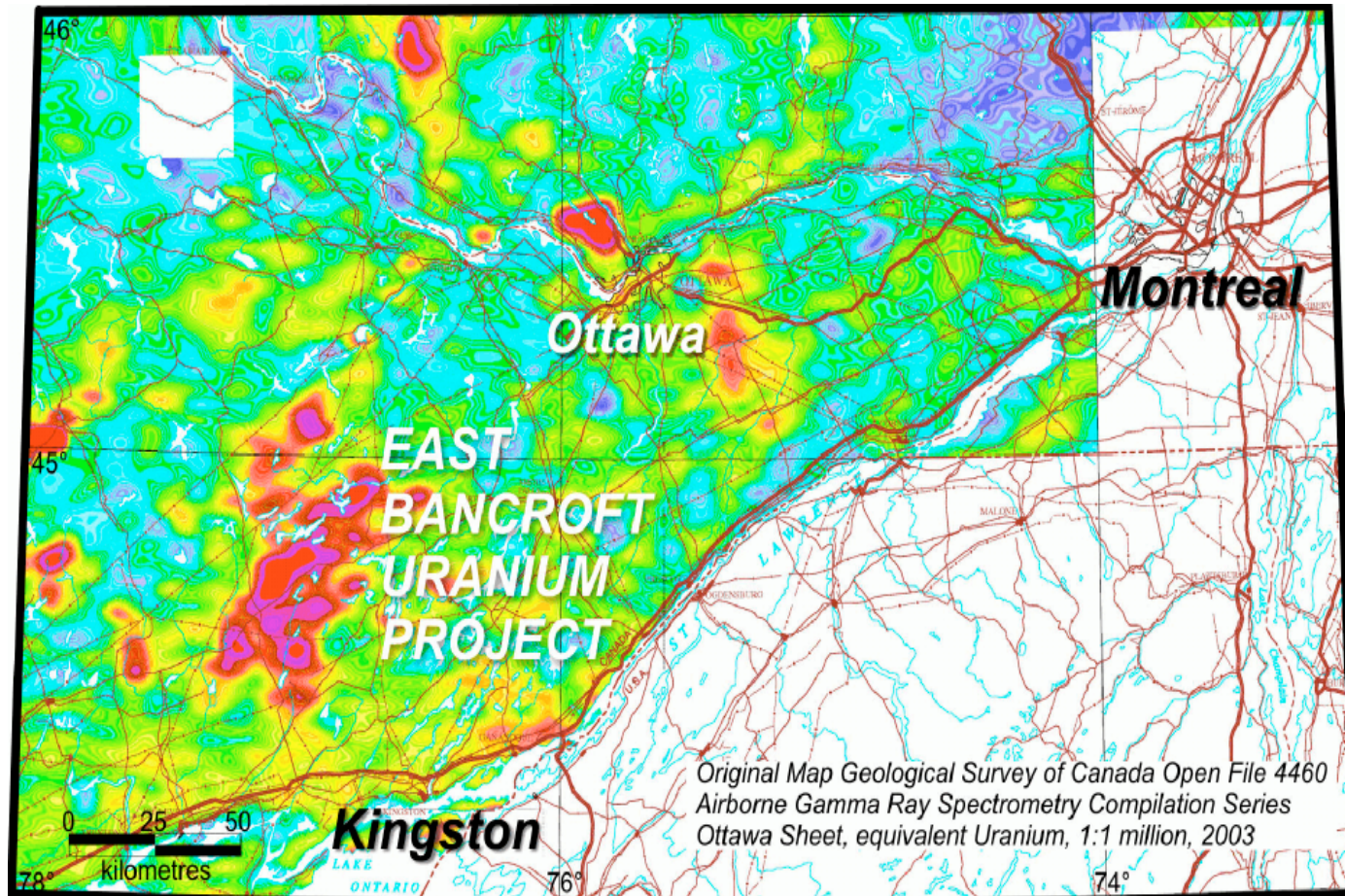

A2A's mandate is to restore, enhance and maintain ecological connectivity, ecosystem function and native biodiversity, while respecting sustainable human land uses, in the distinctive region of Ontario and New York State that lies between and embraces Algonquin and Adirondack Parks.

This is especially important with climate change.

The A2A initiative has an international dimension with New York State. A2A, the people of Ontario and relations with the U.S. could be jeopardized through the provision of mining land use permits within this area.

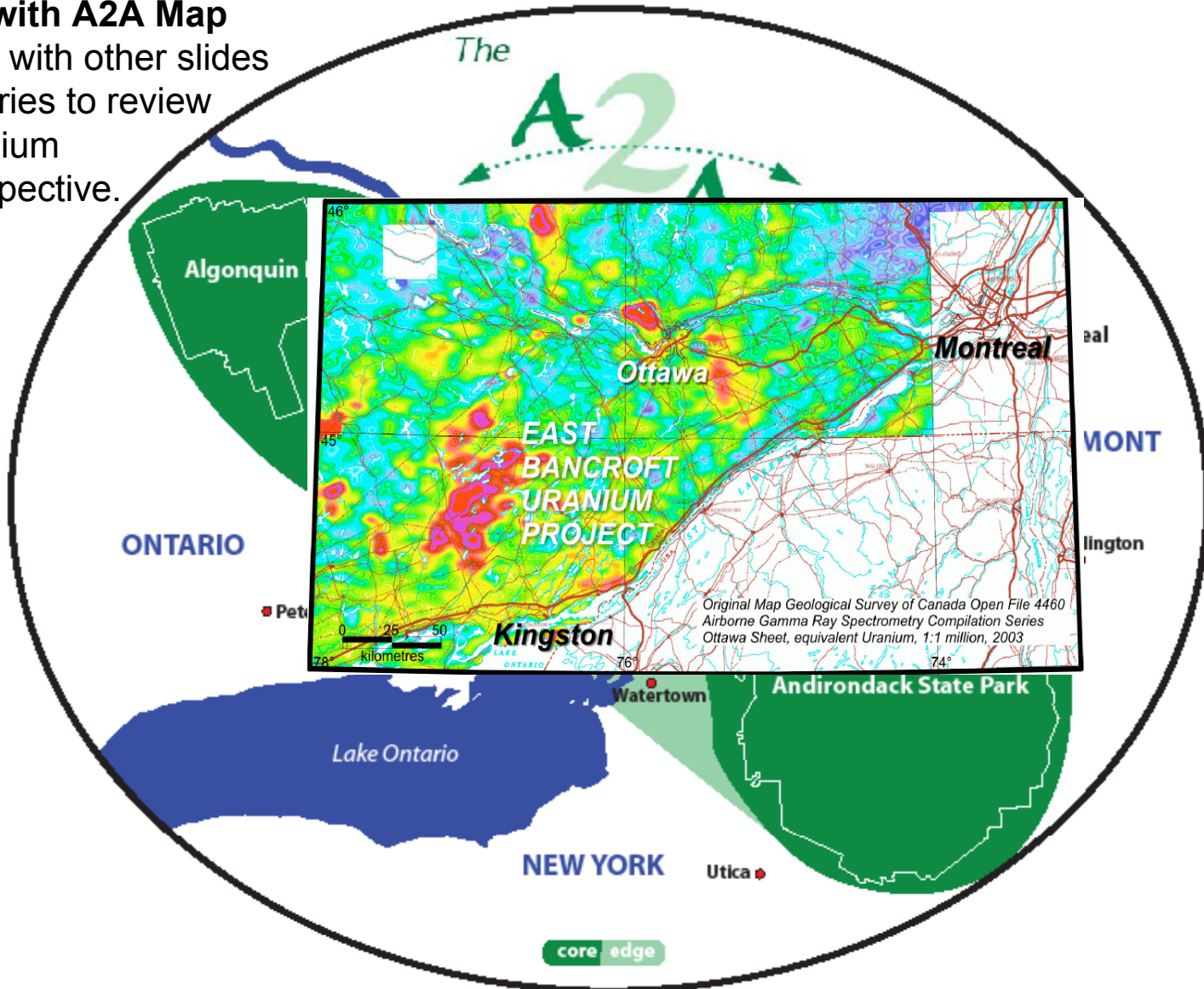
